
## An Original Fantasy Adventure That Sparkles with Storytelling Magic:

## About the Author

Gita Ralleigh grew up reading fantasy adventures that took her to faraway lands. The closest she came was on family holidays to India, where old palaces, ice-capped mountains, monkeys and elephants were part of everyday life. After a career as a medical doctor, she studied for an MA in Creative Writing and published short stories and two poetry books. *The Destiny of Minou Moonshine* is her debut children's novel. She lives in London with her two children and teaches creative writing to undergraduates at Imperial College.

"As a child, I loved fantasy adventures. At the time, I never expected to find a small brown girl within those stories. I was determined that my fantasy adventure, *The Destiny of Minon Moonshine*, would be about a girl like me who discovers both her inheritance and her very own magic. I set my story in Indica, an alternate India, with a dynasty of queens and a goddess, the Dark Lady, who guides Minou to her destiny. I cannot wait for young readers to meet her."
